Loader Operator (MIN/Q0208)

Role Description

A Loader operator drives and operates a Loader which is a heavy vehicle that is used in mines to move aside or load ROM, product etc. into or onto another type of machinery (such as a dump truck, conveyor belt, feed hopper etc. Using a loader is a specialized task that can be safely performed with some training and experience. Safety is extremely critical to avoid property damage and personal injury. Operators are also responsible for performing basic maintenance on the Loader.

Assessment Guidelines

2. The assessment for the theory part will be based on knowledge bank of questions created by the SSC.
3. Individual assessment agencies will create unique question papers for theory part for each candidate at each examination/training centre (as per assessment criteria below)
4. Individual assessment agencies will create unique evaluations for skill practical for every student at each examination/training centre based on this criteria.
5. To pass the Qualification Pack, every trainee should score a minimum of 70% in every NOS
6. In case of successfully passing only certain number of NOS's, the trainee is eligible to take subsequent assessment on the balance NOS's to pass the Qualification Pack
