

Mechanic/Fitter (MIN/Q0304)

A Fitter is responsible for repair, maintenance and overhaul of crushers, heavy earth moving machinery, medium and light vehicles, pumps and compressors and other mechanical equipment and assemblies used in a mine. A fitter most often works with / assists technicians who are more qualified and experienced. The individual must be trained to work safely and assure that he/she can protect himself and others working around him from getting injured.

Assessment Guidelines

- Criteria for assessment for each Qualification Pack will be created by the Sector Skill Council. Each Performance Criteria (PC) will be assigned marks proportional to its importance in NOS. SSC will also lay down proportion of marks for Theory and Skills Practical for each PC
- 2. The assessment for the theory part will be based on knowledge bank of questions created by the SSC.
- 3. Individual assessment agencies will create unique question papers for theory part for each candidate at each examination/training centre (as per assessment criteria below)
 - Individual assessment agencies will create unique evaluations for skill practical for every student at each examination/training centre based on this criteria.
- 5. To pass the Qualification Pack, every trainee should score a minimum of 70% in every NOS
- 6. In case of successfully passing only certain number of NOS's, the trainee is eligible to take subsequent assessment on the balance NOS's to pass the Qualification Pack
